Call for Abstracts: Poster Session

The Center for Agroforestry at the University of Missouri invites abstract submissions for a limited number of contributed poster presentations for the 12th Annual Agroforestry Symposium, to be held January 28-30 2021 on a virtual Symposium platform.

Abstracts are encouraged to address the Symposium theme: “*Community Health & Resilient Food Systems*” or related topics such as environmental health, regenerative agriculture, access and equity in food systems, etc. However, submissions reporting relevant work on related topics (agroforestry, natural resources, nutrition etc.) are also welcome and encouraged.

Posters will be available for attendees to view during the entirety of the event, with a dedicated **Poster Session on Thursday, January 28th, 2021**. At least one poster author should be present to respond to questions and comments during the poster session.

Abstract Guidelines

The proposed poster should report primarily on new work. The body of the abstract may be no more than 380 words, split between the following two sections (up to 190 words each):

Background/ Question/ Methods, in which the objective of the study is clearly identified, and the methods are described; and

Results/ Conclusions, in which specific results or findings of the study are explicitly reported and their implications discussed. Abstracts describing non-traditional work should still address a relevant question and have a “take-home message” describing specific findings.

The abstract header must include the poster title, authors and author affiliations, and primary or attending author email address. Please indicate the presenting author by listing their name in bold. The presenting author should also be the corresponding author.

Submitting authors will receive notification of acceptance and further instructions by email no later than Friday, January 15, 2021.
